	Competition	Symbiosis
Definition	In all environments, organisms compete for the things they need like light, space, water, food, or mates.	is the long-term relationship between different species
Example	Food or water Shark fighting for food. 	Mutualism both benefit (+/+) 
Example	Mate Bucks fighting for the doe. 	Parasitism one is helped and the other is hurt (+/-) 
Example	Territory Bears fighting for the woods. 	Commensalism one is helped and the other one isn't affected (+/0)



producer Noun	an organism, usually a plant, that makes its own food		A flower is a producer because it makes its food from the sun
consumer Noun	an organism that eats other organisms		Fish in the ocean are consumers because they eat other fish.
decomposer Noun	an organism that gets nutrients by breaking down dead organisms		The decomposer is a flower.







	Competition	Symbiosis
Definition	to fight for stuff you need for survival.  - Bears	long term relationship between different species.
Example	Food or water Plants compete for water. 	Mutualism ++ both benefit 
Example	Mate Bears can fight for mates. * 	Parasitism One is helped and the other one is hurt. +/-
Example	Territory Animals such as hippos may fight for territory. 	Commensalism One is helped and the other one isn't effected. +/-

consumer Noun	consume, or eat, produce because they cannot make their own food.		The consumer angrily ate the producer.
decomposer Noun	decompose, or break down organisms		The decomposer broke down the plant.
